## The AusPT 'Safety Brilliance' Award

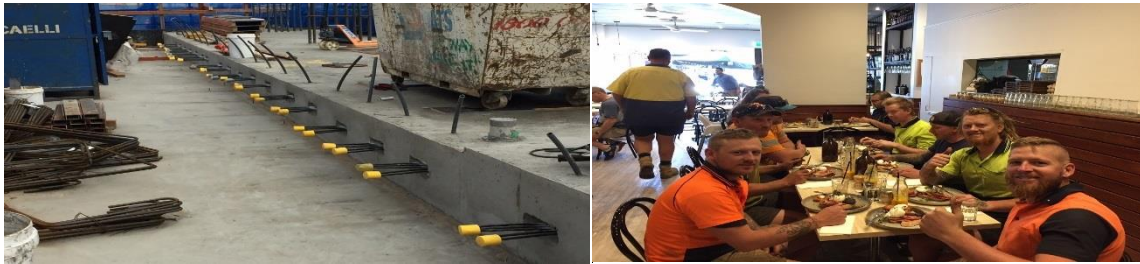
The AusPT 'Safety Brilliance' award will be awarded monthly to a project and its crew that meets the following criteria;
